

RTI in College

This division was established after implementation of Rights to Information Act, 2005 and decided to deal/ reply sought by the public under the provision in this RTI Act, 15/06/2005. Any citizen of India may request information from a “Public Authority” under the provision of this act. It requires replying expeditiously or within thirty days. The Act also requires every public authority to computerize their records for wide dissemination and to proactively certain categories of information so that the citizens need minimum recourse to request for information formally.

According to the provision in the Act, Kalikadevi arts, commerce and science college has decided to depute Public Information Officers in each individual divisions and one Central Public Information Officer (PIO) and First Appellate Authority to dispose of the matter pertaining to Right to Information and if the applicant is not satisfied with reply, then he/she make a 2nd appeal. PIO shall perform the duties and responsibilities as predicted under the act without fail. This kind of information shall be presented to the community at large level through the website. The structure of RTI and works of PIO are available on the Websites.

Activities

This divisions has been receiving RTI applications from general public, teacher pupil, various State Agencies, sister organizations, Ministries and Ministry of HRD, Govt. of India u/clause 6 (3) of the Right to Information Act,2005 within the stipulated time under the Act.
